Results 1 - 10 of about 1810 for How many Church's in Muskegon county. DATE?

In September 2018, we began a review on the subject that noted the top five (5) reasons people listed for not attending church and reviewed the early church, as described in Acts chapter 2, to see what drew so many to the church.

The reasons given:

- 1. The church is irrelevant; the leaders are hypocritical and have experienced too much moral failure.**
- 2. God is missing in the church.**
- 3. Legitimate doubt is prohibited.**
- 4. They're not learning about God. And**
- 5. They're not finding community.**

We would offer some statements for you to consider, as it relates to the subject. Read each and try to imagine how you would feel if it happened to you:

- + You are ill and your friend takes you to the Emergency/Urgent Care Center. When you arrive you are told, “We don’t serve sick people, provide urgent care, or offer help for life threatening problems. “**
- + You are a patient in the hospital and the medical team comes to you room and says, “We are sorry, your problem is listed in the training schedule for next year so you would need to come back at that time.”**
- + You are at a meeting and your child becomes sick. You rush him to the door, but you are told, “You must stay seated. There is no walking during meditation.”**
- + You have rushed all morning to get everyone ready for church, but when you arrive everyone is looking at you because it’s purple day and you are wearing blue.**

The above statements would be laughable if the core meaning was not true. In each example you see unrealistic responses because the people went to the place that claimed to offer the help they needed, but the help was not available, and the reasons had nothing to do with their existence.

An ER that could not meet the purpose. A hospital open but unprepared to serve. The need to respond to an emergency vs. following proper protocol. The body of Christ who was blindsided by the outward color and failed to praise the effort to just be in worship. What do they have in common?

The inability to meet the needs they were designed to provide. The church, the body of believers must live what they believe daily.

We are called to do six (6) things that Jesus placed great importance, that is eternal life.

Matthew 25:31-46 Please read and obey.

³⁷ “Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, ‘Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed *You*, or thirsty and give *You* drink? ³⁸ When did we see You a stranger and take *You* in, or naked and clothe *You*? ³⁹ Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?’ ⁴⁰ And the King will answer and say to them, ‘Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did *it* to one of the least of these My brethren, you did *it* to Me.’

⁴¹ “Then He will also say to those on the left hand, ‘Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: ⁴² for I was hungry and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink; ⁴³ I was a stranger and you did not take Me in, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.’

When we practice obeying the word of God as individuals every day, what we practice will flow in our actions when we come together for worship.

❖ When what is important to God becomes important to us, we will see growth in the body of Christ and funds overflowing to accomplish what he has called us to do.
