WELCOME TO WORD LIVING - LEARNING TO TRUST AND OBEY THE WORD THE MY WAY GENERATION?

Thank you for your prayers as we seek to share the word of God during these trying times.



Because Ecclesiastes 1:9 confirms there is nothing new under the sun, we can see history repeating itself daily.

If we read the word and follow the actions that God spoke, we will avoid some of the hardships associated with disobedience of God's word.

Note: There is a price to pay for even the smallest act of disobedience.

- 1. When God's people obeyed, their enemy could not overtake them even when they were outnumbered. Why? Because God fought for them.**
- 2. When God's people disobeyed, he permitted them to live in captivity and allowed their enemy to rule over them.**

We continue from last month - The people have disobeyed, and the angel comes to bring the news of judgement.

Judges Chapter 2:1-10 (KJV)

And an angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said, I made you to go up out of Egypt, and have brought you unto the land which I swore unto your fathers; and I said, I will never break my covenant with you. And ye shall make no league with the inhabitants of this land; ye shall throw down their altars: but ye have not obeyed my voice: why have ye done this?

Wherefore I also said, I will not drive them out from before you; but they shall be as thorns in your sides, and their gods shall be a snare unto you. And it came to pass, when the angel of the LORD spake these words unto all the children of Israel, that the people lifted up their voice, and wept.

And they called the name of that place Bochim: and they sacrificed there unto the LORD. And when Joshua had let the people go, the children of Israel went every man unto his inheritance to possess the land.

And the people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD, that he did for Israel. And Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died, being an hundred and ten years old.

And they buried him in the border of his inheritance in Timnathheres, in the mount of Ephraim, on the north side of the hill Gaash.

And also all that generation were gathered unto their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, which knew not the LORD, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel.

Let's examine verse 10 for this is a message to us today. There arose another generation after them, which knew not the LORD, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel.

NOTE: How could a generation not know the Lord when God told them to teach the children. Deuteronomy 11:18-19. Could that be the problem we face today?

Note: There is a price to pay for even the smallest act of disobedience:

It is clear they forgot God's command. Deuteronomy 11:18-19 Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes. And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. (KJV) Deuteronomy 4:9 includes teaching your grandchildren.

The failure of God's people to follow his commands brought much pain and sorrow to the next generation who did not know of the history of God, His purpose for mankind, his laws that protected them from harm, his divine intervention at the Red Sea, how he defeated their enemy when their enemy outnumbered them, how he provided for them in the wilderness for forty years, and how God never broke his covenant with Israel even though they were unfaithful.

Could it be that we, have repeated the actions of the past and failed to teach our children and grandchildren about Jesus, his love for us and the sacrifice on the cross that purchased our salvation?

The key question to think about, have we followed the word by living and teaching Jesus, as recorded in the Bible, to your children and grandchildren? Have we reached out and shared the word so that others know about Jesus? We cannot afford to leave this world and fail to teach our children and grandchildren about creation, Biblical history, salvation, daily requirements, death, and eternal life. It is never too late to start or to remind them about the price Jesus paid for their salvation.
