A POINT OF FOCUS

We pause, this month, to remind ourselves of the reason for the celebration of worship. How, from the beginning of time, Jesus Christ, Jesus from the Hebrew word Yeshua which means “savior” or “Yahweh saves”; and Christ, from the Greek word for Messiah, meaning “anointed one” would, in his humanity be born in Bethlehem of Judea, just a few miles south of Jerusalem.
